

Synergy Cables Ltd. Statement Concerning the European Union's REACH Substance of Very High Concern (SVHC)

- Synergy Cables Ltd. (Hereinafter Synergy) is a producer of cables & in terms of REACH regulation a "Down Stream User" of chemical substances.
 - Synergy does not produce raw materials or chemicals, it is therefore not necessary to register Synergy products.
 - This document certifies that the LV cables manufactured by Synergy do not contain any of the Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) listed on the most current Candidate List published on the ECHA website (Last updated 15 February 2017) above the reportable limits based on composition information for the raw materials.
1. The EC Regulation No. 1907/2006 on Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH) entered in force on June 1, 2007 and subject to amendments. The identification of a substance as a Substance of Very High Concern (SVHC) and its inclusion in the Candidate List creates certain legal obligations for the importers, producers and suppliers of an article that contains such a substance.
 2. REACH defines an article as an object which during production is given a special shape, surface or design that determines its function to a greater degree than its chemical composition. The list is frequently amended and is available from <http://echa.europa.eu/web/guest/candidate-list-table>.
 3. The business is a downstream user and as such we are liable for communication of information towards our customers, we are not liable for registration of substances. Chemical substances contained in our products, which may possibly be subject to registration, have to be registered by our suppliers who in turn must advise us about content.
 4. We maintain contact with our suppliers to avoid SVHC materials being included in our products. They are also required annually to provide a statement against the latest candidate listing. Based on the response statements of our suppliers no materials from the ECHA Candidate List are included in our products or packages. Should it be found that our products or packages contain SVHC materials in the future, we will inform our customers immediately.
 5. Synergy will continue to monitor changes to the REACH legislation and react accordingly.
 6. The information provided in this document is correct to the best of our knowledge at the date of publication.
